

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Vicente, Sirawai, Zamboanga del Norte

as of 01 August, 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 July 2023 at around 8:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Vicente, Sirawai, Zamboanga del Norte. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the fire was due to faulty electrical short circuit and was declared out at around 9:30 AM.
