

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. St. Peter, Quezon City as of 29 August 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 August 2023 at around 11:52 PM, a fire incident occurred at Scout Alcaraz Corner, Banawe St., Brgy. St. Peter, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 1:22 AM the next day.
