

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Talon 5, Las Piñas City as of 24 August 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 August 2023 at around 6:50 PM, a fire incident occurred at Chesa St., Golden Acres Subdivision, Brgy. Talon 5, Las Piñas City. The fire was declared out at around 7:44 PM.
