

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Influenza Outbreak in T'boli, South Cotabato

as of 24 June 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 June 2023, the Municipal Health Office of T'boli, South Cotabato declared an influenza outbreak and recommended a community quarantine for the affected areas of the said municipality after several confirmed cases were reported from Sitio Blo, Sitio Datal Bong, Sitio Tahikong, and Sitio Syumbulon in Brgy. Salacafe.

Seasonal influenza is an acute respiratory infection caused by influenza viruses which circulate in all parts of the world.

A total of **120 families** or **135 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Salacafe, T'boli, South Cotabato** (see Table 1).
