2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 107,605 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 15,493 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 92,112 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
