I. Situation Overview

On 20 August 2023 at around 8:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Tambucho Drive, Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City. The fire was declared under control at around 10:36 PM.

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 100,354 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 81,576 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 18,778 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

The LGU of Zamboanga City provided food packs, hot meals, portable toilets (portalets), jerry cans, and modular tents while the Department of Health (DOH) 9 provided hygiene kits, jerry cans, and drinking water to the affected families and individuals.
