

DSWD DROMIC Report #31 on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon and Super Typhoon “Egay” as of 20 August 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 July 2023, “Egay” maintained its strength as it moved West Northwestward and exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

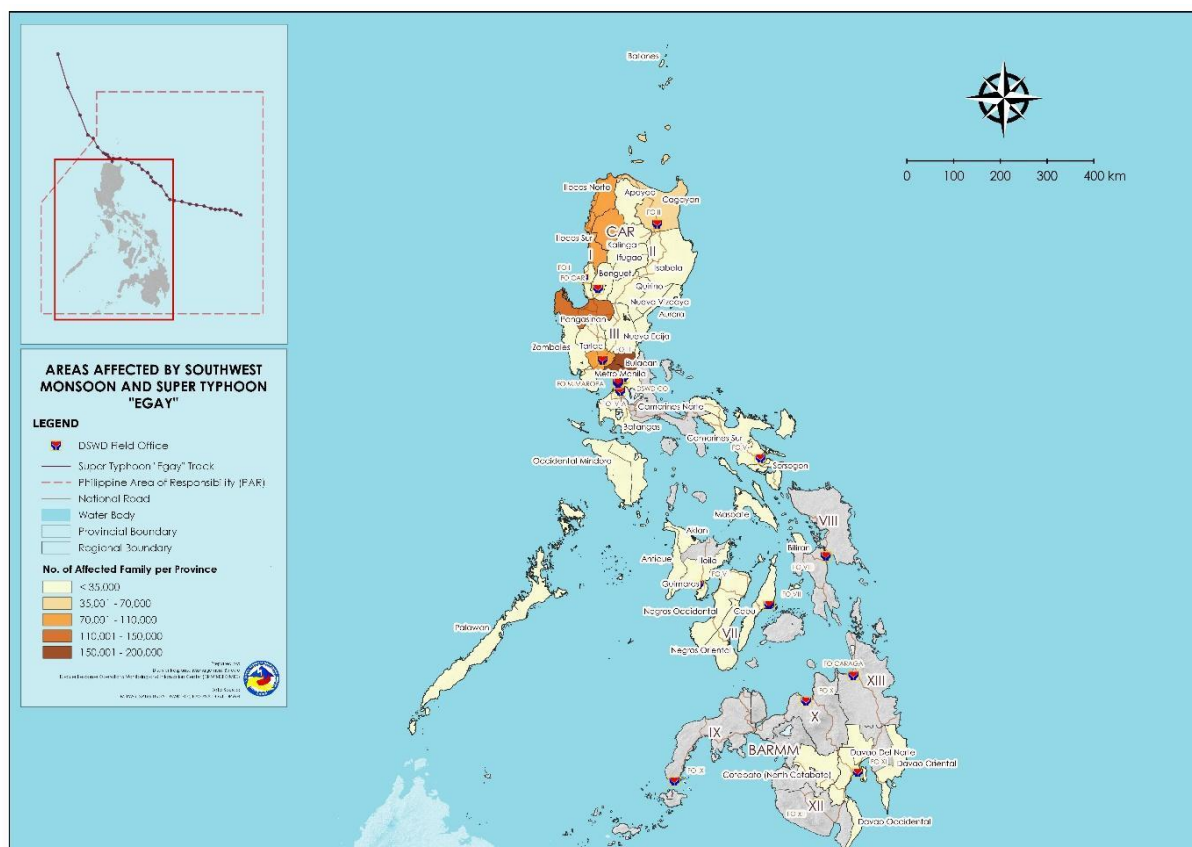

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱411,081,338.99** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱348,160,302.63** from **DSWD**, **₱56,990,895.92** from **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱968,869.93** from **Non-Government Organizations**, and **₱4,961,270.51** from the **other Partners** (see Table 6).
