I. Situation Overview

On 27 July 2023, “Egay” maintained its strength as it moved West Northwestward and exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

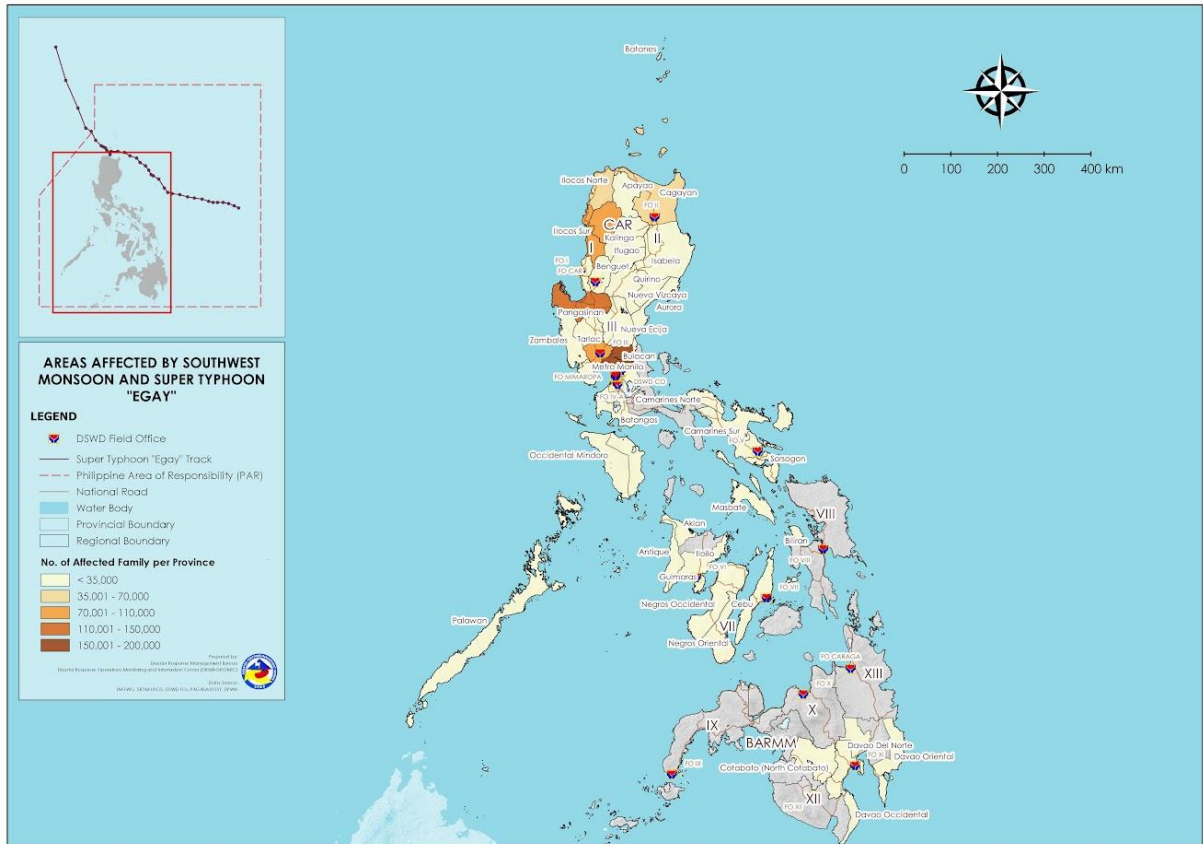

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱420,918,779.21** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱357,527,242.85** from **DSWD**, **₱57,446,145.92** from **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱984,119.93** from **Non-Government Organizations**, and **₱4,961,270.51** from the **other Partners** (see Table 6).
