



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Surigao del Sur

23 October 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 July 2023 at around 9:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Almara, Brgy. Bigaan, Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the alleged members of the New People's Army (NPA) which also affected the nearby Brgy. Santa Juana in Tagbina, Surigao del Sur.

A total of **359 families** or **1,356 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Surigao del Sur** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **76 families** or **334 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Surigao del Sur** (see Table 2).
