





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Sangke, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental

22 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On August 1, 2023 at around 8:00 AM, strong gusty winds swept through residential areas in Barangay Sangke, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental hence, one (1) house sustained partial damage due to a fallen coconut tree.

As per the report from the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO), a family of five persons was affected by the incident. Fortunately, there were no reported casualties or displacements during the occurrence.
