I. Situation Overview

On 12 September 2023 at around 12NN, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Camandag, Leon, Iloilo between the 61st Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA). *Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI*

A total of **210 families** or **890 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Camandag, Leon, Iloilo** (see Table 1).
