



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol

as of 08 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2023 at around 7:30AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Ilaud, Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol between the Philippine Army's 47th Infantry (Katapatan) Batallion and the alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA).
