

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Jayobo, Lambunao, Iloilo as of 21 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 September 2023 at around 6:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of 82<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Battalion – Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People’s Army (CPP-NPA) at Sitio Agdalsan, Brgy. Jayubo, Lambunao, Iloilo.
