as of 20 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 September 2023, the 10th Infantry Battalion – Philippine Army Detachment in Brgy. Nueva Vista (Mansawan), Don Victoriano Chiongbian, Misamis Occidental conducted a blocking operation in Brgy. Napangan of the said municipality and engaged in a firefight against the alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA).
