

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Tubungan, Iloilo

as of 09 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2023 at around 2PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Bato, Tubungan, Iloilo between the 61<sup>st</sup> Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that also affected the nearby barangays of Cadabdab and Igdampog Sur in Tubungan, Iloilo.

A total of **31 families** or **146 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Tubungan, Iloilo** (see Table 1).
