

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon in Bohol as of 29 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 01 August 2023, the Province of Bohol reported that the Southwest Monsoon which caused strong to gale force winds and rough sea conditions has affected the livelihood of families and individuals (mostly fisher folks) residing in coastal and island barangays.

On 04 August 2023, the Municipality of Loay, Bohol also reported that Southwest Monsoon has affected the livelihood of several fisher folks in its area of responsibility.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **24,357 families** or **95,079 persons** are affected in **86 barangays** in **Bohol** (see Table 1).
