I. Situation Overview

On 06 September 2023 at around 6:18 AM, a fire incident occurred at Globo de Oro St., Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 7:54 AM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱27.82 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.9 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 100,354 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 81,576 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 18,778 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 8,194 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱300.76 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

DSWD FO NCR through its QRT members conducted Rapid Damaged and Need Assessment (RDANA) in the inflicted area. DSWD FO NCR ensures the availability of FNIs.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO NCR for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
