I. Situation Overview

On 11 September 2023 at around 4:20 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 43-B, Tacloban City. The fire was declared out at around 5:45 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱18.57 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 114,972 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 76,221 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 38,751 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

13 September 2023	 DSWD FO VIII continuously coordinates with the affected LGU and other concerned offices for significant updates and any relief augmentation requests. DSWD FO VII referred the affected families to the Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) for financial assistance.
