1. Standby Funds

- ₱27.82 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 98,823 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 70,045 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 28,778 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 36,152 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱337.42 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
