

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Calingatngan, Borongan City, Eastern Samar

### I. Situation Overview

On 15 September 2023 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Calingatngan, Borongan City, Eastern Samar. The fire was declared out at around 5PM.
