- ₱332.4 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.

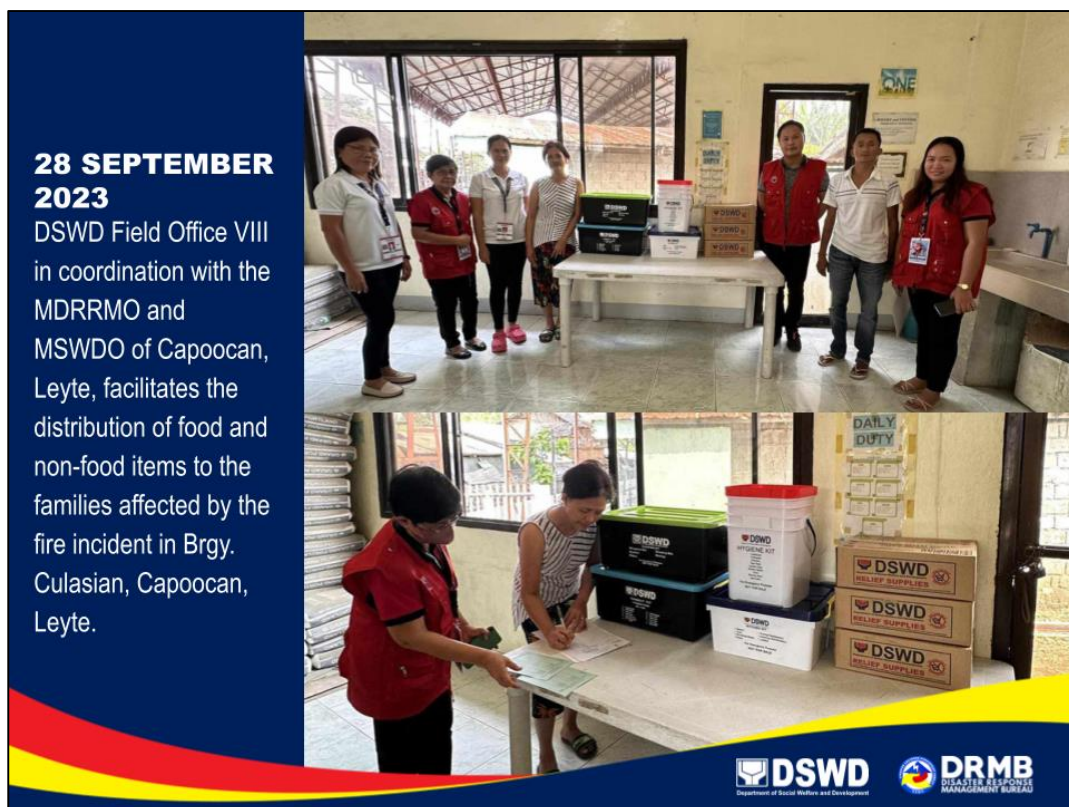
