- 169,808 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 113,307 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 56,501 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 41,365 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱350.34 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
