I. Situation Overview

On 30 August 2023 at around 9AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Malaguicay, Abuyog, Leyte.

A total of **four (4) families** or **16 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Malaguicay**, **Abuyog**, **Leyte** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱18.57 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VIII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 108,244 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 69,493 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 38,751 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 47,928 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱337.54 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.

04 September 2023	DSWD FO VIII in coordination with the MSWDO requested for the provision of psychosocial first aid to the affected families and individuals.
	DSWD FO VIII referred the affected families to Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) for financial assistance.
