I. Situation Overview

On 14 September 2023 at around 1:40 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mambulac, Silay City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 3:53 AM.

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 129,994 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 69,493 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 56,501 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 17,373 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱302.86 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
