19 September 2023	 DSWD FO X in coordination with the LGU of Naawan, Misamis Oriental provided food and non-food items such as FFPs, ready- to-eat (RTEF) food, hygiene kits, sleeping kits, kitchen kits, and family kits intended for distribution to the affected families and individuals.
27 August 2023	 The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of the LGU of Naawan, Misamis Oriental provided food items such as rice and canned goods, and financial assistance to the affected families and individuals.
