I. Situation Overview

1. Standby Funds

- ₱5.49 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 123,163 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 63,225 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 59,938 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 32,793 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱279.51 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
