### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 117,667 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 93,805 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 23,862 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
