

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Port Poyohon, Butuan City

### I. Situation Overview

On 11 September 2023 at around 11:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, Brgy. Port Poyohon, Butuan City. The fire was declared out on 12 September 2023 at around 1:37 AM.
