

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tejero, Cebu City as of 11 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 September 2023 at around 1:36 PM, a fire incident occurred at Alviola St., Sitio Back Blessed, Villa Gonzalo II, Brgy. Tejero, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 2:15 PM.
