- 131,969 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 73,731 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 58,238 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 8,651 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱295.96 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
