

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Concepcion, Asuncion, Davao del Norte

as of 12 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On September 08 2023 at around 11PM, a flash flood incident occurred in Brgy. Concepcion Asuncion, Davao del Norte due to the Localized Thunderstorm.

- 134,512 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 95,761 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 38,751 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 34,707 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
