



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. Daug, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental

as of 19 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 September 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 3:45: PM, flooding was experienced in a low-lying area in in Brgy. Daug, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by localized thunderstorms.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items
