



# **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the** Mw 6.3 Earthquake Incident in Calayan, Cagayan

as of 13 September 2023, 6PM

#### I. **Situation Overview**

On 12 September 2023 at 7:03 PM, a 6.3-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Calayan, Cagayan (19.26°N, 121.13°E - 019 km N 25°) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 031 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.
