#### I. Situation Overview

On 17 September 2023, the 10<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion – Philippine Army Detachment in Brgy. Nueva Vista (Mansawan), Don Victoriano Chiongbian, Misamis Occidental conducted a blocking operation in Brgy. Napangan of the said municipality and engaged in a firefight against the alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA).

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **300 families** or **945 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Napangan, Don Victoriano Chiongbian, Misamis Occidental** (see Table 2).
