



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Lambunao, Iloilo

as of 23 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 September 2023 at around 6:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the Philippine Army's 82nd Infantry Battalion (IB) and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in Lambunao, Iloilo. According to reports, the said encounter initially transpired at Sitio Agdalusan, Brgy. Jayubo and has eventually affected nearby barangays during the follow-up operations conducted by the Philippine Army.

A total of 265 families or 1,342 persons are affected in six (6) barangays in Lambunao, Iloilo (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱5.49 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 157,900 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 93,287 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 64,613 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 18,582 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱288.05 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
