

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Quezon, Bukidnon

as of 19 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 September 2023, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Linabo, Quezon, Bukidnon between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that also affected the nearby Brgy. Cawayan also in Quezon, Bukidnon.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **140 families** or **700 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Quezon, Bukidnon** (see Table 1).

### III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱310,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱210,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱100,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Table 2).
