

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Tubungan, Iloilo

as of 15 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2023 at around 2PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Bato, Tubungan, Iloilo between the 61st Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that also affected the nearby barangays of Cadabdab and Igdampog Sur in Tubungan, Iloilo.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **108 families** or **286 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Tubungan, Iloilo** (see Table 1).
