



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Tubungan, Iloilo

as of 15 September 2023, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2023 at around 2PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Bato, Tubungan, Iloilo between the 61<sup>st</sup> Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that also affected the nearby barangays of Cadabdab and Igdampog Sur in Tubungan, Iloilo.

A total of 108 families or 286 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Tubungan, Iloilo (see Table 1).

# 1. Standby Funds

- ₱18.57 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 125,994 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 69,493 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 56,501 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 45,882 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱302.86 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
