

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City as of 12 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 September 2023 at around 6:18 AM, a fire incident occurred at Globo de Oro St., Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 7:54 AM.

A total of **152 families** or **610 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City** (see Table 1).
