I. Situation Overview

On 15 September 2023 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Calingatngan, Borongan City, Eastern Samar. The fire was declared out at around 5PM.

DSWD FO VIII coordinated CSWDO of Borongan City and requested for provision of psychological first-aid to the affected families and individuals.
