I. Situation Overview

On 15 September 2023 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Calingatngan, Borongan City, Eastern Samar. The fire was declared out at around 5PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱5.49 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VIII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 147,222 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 79,709 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 67,513 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 35,258 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱340 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

21 September 2023	 DSWD FO VIII facilitated the augmentation of FFPs, family kits, sleeping kits, hygiene kits, kitchen kits, and other FNIs intended for distribution to the affected families and individuals.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

DATE	ACTIVITIES
18 September 2023	 DSWD FO VIII in coordination with the Borongan City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) and CDRRMO conducted an assessment and profiling of the displaced affected families and individuals.

d. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
21 September 2023	 DSWD FO VIII closely coordinated with the affected LGU and other concerned offices for significant updates and further relief augmentation requests.
18 September 2023	 DSWD FO VIII facilitated the referral of the affected families to the Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) for possible financial assistance. DSWD FO VIII coordinated CSWDO of Borongan City and requested for provision of psychological first-aid to the affected families and individuals.
