

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Bongao, Tawi-Tawi

as of 11 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2023 at around 1:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at Kahapan St., Brgy. Poblacion, Bongao, Tawi-Tawi. The fire was declared out at around 6PM.
