



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flash Flood Incidents in Davao Region

as of 18 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 September 2023 at around 11PM, a flash flood incident occurred in Brgy. Concepcion Asuncion, Davao del Norte due to localized thunderstorms.

On 14 September 2023, several more municipalities in the provinces of Davao de Oro, Davao del Norte, and Davao Occidental also experienced flash floods due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the Southwest Monsoon / Localized Thunderstorms.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱18.57 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 169,808 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 113,307 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 56,501 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 34,707 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱332.67 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.
