

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in Padada, Davao del Sur

as of 28 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 September 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by the Southwest Monsoon / Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of Mindanao area.

On the same day, several barangays in Padada, Davao del Sur experienced flooding due to heavy rainfall caused by the Southwest Monsoon.

A total of **1,362 families** or **5,461 persons** are affected in **nine (9) barangays** in Padada, Davao del Sur (see Table 1).

There are **11 families** or **44 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Almendras Gym** in **Padada, Davao del Sur** (see Table 2).
