



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Shooting Incident in Brgy. Labungan, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte

as of 29 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 September 2023 at around 5AM, a shooting incident transpired at Sitio Tubaran, Brgy. Labungan, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte. According to reports, an armed group fired towards the residences of the affected families and individuals who are Indigenous People (IP) which resulted in their displacement.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **298 families** or **1,490 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Labungan, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Table 1).
