



DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Bongao, Tawi-Tawi

as of 13 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2023 at around 1:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at Kahapan St., Brgy. Poblacion, Bongao, Tawi-Tawi. The fire was declared out at around 6PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱18.57 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO IX.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 114,972 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 76,221 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 38,751 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 44,348 FFPs available at DSWD FO IX.
- ₱369.37 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO IX warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

10 September 2023	 DSWD FO IX in coordination with the Ministry of Social Services and Development (MSSD) of Tawi-Tawi facilitated the distribution of FFPs, hygiene kits, sleeping kits, family kits, and modular tents to the affected families and individuals.
09 September 2023	 DSWD FO IX in coordination with the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Region IX through its Naval Forces Western Mindanao transported the FNIs for distribution to the affected families in Bongao, Tawi-Tawi.
08 September 2023	 DSWD FO IX through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) is closely coordinating with the affected Local Government Unit (LGU) and the RDRRMC-IX for the provision of FNIs to the families affected by the fire incident.
