

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Bongao, Tawi-Tawi

as of 13 September 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2023 at around 1:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at Kahapan St., Brgy. Poblacion, Bongao, Tawi-Tawi. The fire was declared out at around 6PM.

08 September 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSWD FO IX through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) is closely coordinating with the affected Local Government Unit (LGU) and the RDRRMC-IX for the provision of FNIs to the families affected by the fire incident.
