

## DSWD DROMIC Report #40 on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon and Super Typhoon “Egay” as of 13 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 27 July 2023, “Egay” maintained its strength as it moved West Northwestward and exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

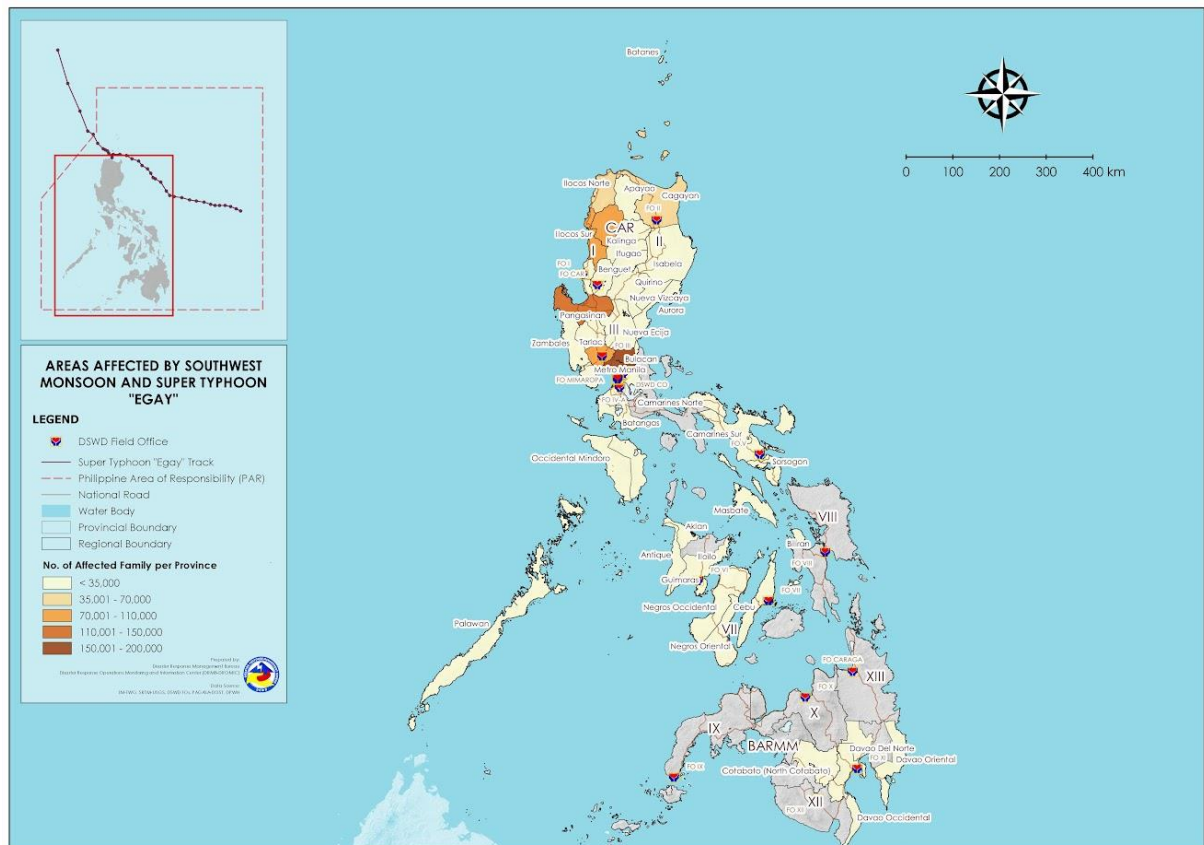

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱455,482,120.20** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱392,040,848.84** from **DSWD**, **₱57,495,880.92** from **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱984,119.93** from **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)**, and **₱4,961,270.51** from the **other Partners** (see Table 6).
