

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. III Poblacion, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental

11 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 June 2023 at around 3PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. III Poblacion, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) the fire caused was due to faulty electrical wirings. The fire was declared out at around 3:46 PM.
