

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Buguias, Benguet

13 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 13 May 2023 at around 9:50 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Nilawitan, Brgy. Poblacion, Buguias, Benguet. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) – Buguias, the cause of fire was due to an electrical short circuit or overloading.
